
My father cooks the meat for our meal.





Hedgehogs

Hedgehogs live in many countries of the world. In England, there is only one type of hedgehog. It has brown fur on its stomach. In Iraq, for example, there are different types of hedgehog. One type has white <u>fur</u> on its <u>stomach</u>. The second type has long ears. All types of hedgehogs have long <u>spines</u>.



When hedgehogs are frightened, they go into a ball. Hedgehogs can run and they can swim too! Most hedgehogs are <u>nocturnal</u>. That means they sleep in the day, and at night they look for food.

First aid for cuts









Small cuts

First, wash the cut. Use a lot of water. It's a good idea to use soap too. Make sure the cut is clean. Then <u>dry</u> the cut with a clean <u>towel</u>. Next, put <u>antiseptic cream</u> on the cut. Finally, put a clean <u>plaster</u> on the cut.

Big cuts

These can be dangerous. Don't put plasters on a big cut. Cover the cut with a clean towel. Go to the hospital and see a doctor.
